Tri-M® is the only national honor society for student musicians in grades 6-12. Each year, the over **75,000 students** in Tri-M chapters contribute more than **750,000 service hours** to their schools and communities, and **raise nearly \$1 million** for causes they care about.

- Willingness to meet once per month to plan chapter activities and service projects
